The grasslands of Central Asia are home to the Kyrgyz people. Traditionally the Kyrgyz were nomadic herders who lived in circular felt tents known as yurts and migrated annually with their flocks. They would take all their possessions with them, unless breakable things had no place in their homes. Recently more Kyrgyz have settled in towns and cities, however, they still make traditional household items, like the patterned reed screens (chimgecan chiy) used to furnish the yurt.




Reeds & Wool panel layout






